

## Berwick St Mary's CE First School Sports Funding: 2015 -2016



In 2015-2016 we received approximately £8400 P.E. and School Sport Funding. We are spending the amount in the following ways:

£6000	Employ specialist P.E. teachers and coaches.	<p>To provide staff the opportunity to work alongside specialist teachers and coaches to develop their CPD in teaching P.E.</p> <p>To provide an opportunity for pupils to work with specialist teachers and coaches.</p> <p>To provide additional after school sport clubs.</p>	<p>NQTs have benefited from observing and working alongside experienced specialist teachers thus improving their skills and subject knowledge in a wide range of sports.</p> <p>Pupils continue to be enthusiastic about learning in P.E. with many children attending after school clubs and competitions.</p> <p>We have been able to provide two sports based after school clubs per week throughout the year, this has also strengthened links with sports clubs in the area.</p>
£450	Employ a specialist Dance teacher	<p>To provide staff the opportunity to work alongside a specialist dance teacher to develop their CPD.</p> <p>To provide a subsidised dance club. We recognise dance promotes a sense of well-being and creativity, it encourages children to be active and healthy, developing motor skills. It allows children to develop their social skills through group activities.</p>	<p>This continues to be a popular club with the children in Years 2-4. This year the children performed for the parents at an end of year show, this developed their self-confidence, with reluctant performers choosing to join in. We have noticed that the children have developed more creative skills and have worked well collaboratively with children not in their peer group.</p>
£600	Provision of transport to a wide range of sporting events e.g. cross country, football, tag-rugby etc.	To provide transport so the children can attend a wider range of sporting events.	Pupils have the opportunity to participate in a wide range of sporting activities and inter-school competitions. The children have been successful in many of the competitions.
£500	Subsidise the Y4 residential trip.	To reduce the cost to parents so more ch'd could participate in the residential trip. The trip includes many outdoor and adventurous activities and develops teamwork.	Nearly all children in Year 4 participated in the residential trip. Staff commented that the range of outdoor and adventurous activities had an impact on the children's self-confidence and perseverance as well as further developing social skills.

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£400	Provide supply for PE. lead to develop and organise intra and inter school festivals and competitions.	To provide intra school competitions during curriculum time. To provide inter school festivals and school competitions during curriculum and after school.	The P.E. lead was able to liaise with the specialist teachers to organise intra-school competitions as well as releasing her to lead intra-school competitions with other classes in the school. This contributed to the school achieving the School Games Mark Silver Award.
£500	Purchase additional sports resources and equipment.	To ensure children are physically active throughout the school day. To promote social skills and to give children the opportunity to learn new games and skills.  To buy additional equipment and replace broken equipment.	Equipment is available to the Year 4 playground leaders to deliver games during playtimes. This has provided them with a sense of responsibility and has developed their leadership skills. This has also encouraged younger children to be more active during playtimes and apply their physical skills in a range of activities.  All children have access to suitable quality equipment during P.E. lessons and after school clubs.
