



#### Outdoor learning/allotment

The children have the opportunity to explore types of rocks and soil during science. The children will be learning about garden birds and identifying them for a Bird survey around school.

#### MFL

The children will learn new vocabulary, so they can count, know colours and different foods in French. So, they can have a conversation about their likes and dislikes. They will develop their pronunciation and confidence.

#### Homework

- Topic – End of half term (This should be topic based, the children should choose the activity of their own choice.)
- Spelling – Friday for Thursday
- Reading – Daily (Reading challenge 3 times a week for 10 weeks)
- Numeracy – Friday for Friday

#### Humanities

This half term the children will be extending their knowledge and understanding of the position and significance of the Equator, Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere. They will identify the position and significance of the Arctic and the Antarctic Circle. They will locate the Mediterranean and understand why it is a popular destination. Children will use geographical language, use atlases, maps and read basic map symbols.

#### Art & Design

The children will create world flags using pointillism. They will have to draw accurately and consider the colours. The children will look at work by Michael Tompsett and use water colours to create their own world map. We will think about layering to create a landscape. The children will create their own landscape of world landmarks. The children will evaluate their work and suggest improvements to their own piece.

#### PE

Mr Moor will be developing our dance skills through performing dances using a range of movement patterns. Using dynamic, rhythmic and expressive qualities clearly and with control. The children will also attend swimming lessons to increase confidence, swim competently using a range of strokes. Improve their understanding of safety in and around water.

## Curriculum Map: Explorers

#### RE

The children will learn about Jewish lifestyles. They will listen to the story of Abraham and Sarah to understand the promise God made to Abraham. The children will compare stories from the Torah to those in the bible.

#### ICT

The children will learn to use power point and make their own simple power point presentation on explorers. They will use text and graphics to create different effects to engage their audience.

#### British Values

The children will explore the different fundamentals of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect and tolerance of those with different beliefs. We will discuss how these happen in Great Britain.

#### PSHCE

The children will discuss our core values across the school. We will discuss health and well-being including physical, mental and emotional health. We will talk about the importance of healthy eating and exercise.
