

# Curriculum Map: The Romans



**Outdoor learning/allotment**

The children will continue to explore the allotments and look after their produce. They will watch the salads change and then harvest their crops.

**MFL**

The children will learn new vocabulary, so they can count and know colours in French. So, they can have a conversation about their likes and dislikes.

**Homework**

- Topic – End of half term (This should be topic based, the children should choose the activity of their own choice.)
- Spelling – Friday for Thursday
- Reading – Daily (Reading challenge 3 times a week for 10 weeks)

**Humanities**

This half term the children will be extending their knowledge and understanding of the history in Britain with the focus on the invasion of the Romans. The children will focus on the extreme earth, learning about volcanoes and earthquakes whilst linking this with the story of 'Pompeii'.

**Art & Design**

The children will follow instructions to make a model. They will then discuss how they could make their model different by suggesting alternatives to improve their model and then test the changes made. The children will think about what they found in the test to design and make their own version of the first model made. Finally the children will evaluate their end model.

**PE**

This half term the children will be developing their athletic skills with Mr Moor. They will develop an understanding of how to improve their physical self during different activities. They will focus on running, throwing and jumping. The children will continue to play team games to improve their communication and competing with each other in a friendly manner.

**RE**

The children will explore Christianity and being part of a community. They will think about worship and rites of passage and ceremonies that mark transitions in life.

**ICT**

The children will develop their programming skills. They will be thinking about designing and creating a programme using a range of digital devices to accomplish their end goal.

**British Values**

The children will explore the different fundamentals of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect and tolerance of those with different beliefs. We will discuss how these happen in Great Britain.

**PSHCE**

The children will continue to think about healthy lifestyles and the different things that make food healthy. We will think about moving on as we prepare for the next steps in our school journey.
